The I-CAMP will provide advanced interdisciplinary expert training usually not available within the traditional system of graduate education and postdoctoral apprenticeship, attracting early-career scientists from both academia and industry.

- Week 3 (Corrientes Iguazu Falls, Argentina): Emergent phenomena in metamaterials, photonic crystals, and nano-scale optoelectronics
